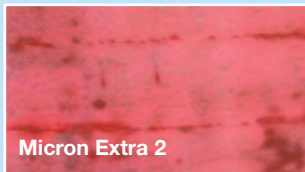

Micron Extra 2 is a high strength polishing antifouling, incorporating Biolux technology, that provides protection in most fouling conditions.

Self polishing technology ensures a continuous renewal of the active layer of the paint so your hull stays cleaner and smoother for longer and there's no heavy paint build-up.



Trial Results

Boat trial: *Western Mediterranean, April 2010 – May 2011*

A patch of Micron Extra 2 was applied to a vessel sailing in the Western Mediterranean. After 12 months Micron Extra 2 has significantly less fouling than Micron Extra.

- Available in a range of colours and pack sizes to suit all boat sizes value for money and less waste.

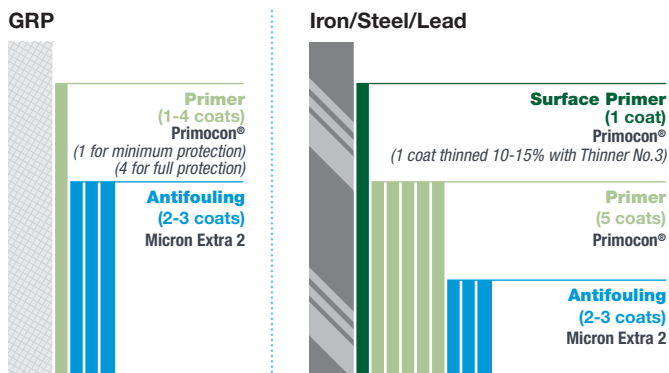
Thinning is not recommended. However, for equipment cleaning, the specified thinner can be used. ** Not all colours are available in all sizes. Please consult your International representative for more information.



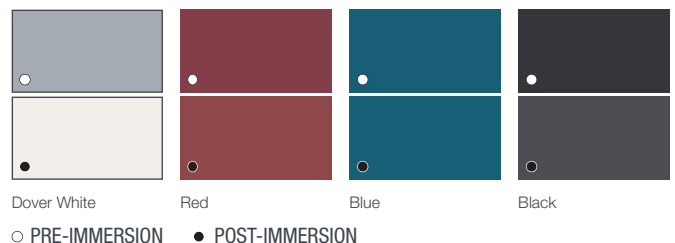

Questions & Answers

What's different about this products from the Micron Extra that I have used in the past?

Antifouling paints contain biocides, which are the active ingredients that stop your boat hull from fouling, and biocidal legislation around the globe is changing so we have updated our paint formulations to meet new and future legislation. This ensures that you have the latest technology and environmental standards available for your boat across our whole range of products, but particularly antifouling, to protect your hull from slime, weed and shell fouling.

When will Micron Extra 2 be available?

For New Zealand and Asia, Micron Extra 2 will be available from early 2016. Australia will adopt products as registrations are approved later in 2016.

Will there be new SKUs?

Yes, the product will have its own unique SKU codes.

Will the performance be the same?

Performance will be as good as or better than the current product.

Is the new product safer to use?

Micron Extra 2 has much the same health and safety profile as Micron Extra and it must be remembered that any biocide-containing antifouling must be handled with great care at all times. Personal protective equipment, including suitable gloves and eye protection, should be used. Refer to the products' material safety datasheet on yachtpaint.com for more information.

Can I get the same colors and pack sizes as previously?

Micron Extra 2 is available in the same pack sizes as Micron Extra and colours will be similar after immersion.

Will application rates and film builds differ?

Micron Extra 2 volume solids remains unchanged at 60% and it has the same application rates and film builds as Micron Extra. A new data sheet will be available on yachtpaint.com.

What about Lloyds IMO tin free certification?

Micron Extra 2 has certification and it will be available on AUS/NZ/Asia yachtpaint.com along with the other tin free certificates. It is good until 2018. Look for certificate number MND/2015/6829.

Can Micron Extra 2 be mixed with Micron Extra?

We never recommend physically mixing antifouling of different formulations as the outcome can, at best, be unpredictable and they may not be compatible in some proportions. Should you have cans of old and new then each should be applied separately.

What about compatibility when overcoating other products?

Micron Extra 2 is compatible for over-coating the same antifouling as Micron Extra so, for more information, check the Antifouling Compatibility Chart on yachtpaint.com by clicking on the Literature & News tab.
